- Focusing on the development and the improvement of the previously used workshop materials based on the feedback given after the last wave.
- Conducting research needed for improvement materials and implementing the changes in the materials.
- Hosting online team meetings relating to the content of the Better Together workshops.
- Participating in the Social Impact Initiative Team meetings and Project Team online meetings.
- Reporting the outcomes of the process in the end of the grant cycle.
