

Role description:

An EFPSA Social Impact Initiative (SII) Local Coordinator (LC) is a contact person between their National Coordinator (NC) and local volunteers (and the EFPSA SII team if needed). It is a position for people who are interested in implementing or further developing the “Mind the Mind - *to Combat the Stigma of Mental Disorders*” campaign in their region/city.

The main responsibilities of LCs are:

- gathering and coordinating a local group of volunteers on behalf of EFPSA SII;
- closely collaborating with their NC;
- providing volunteers with the materials, guidelines, and information and distributing the tasks to them;
- promoting the project among potential volunteers and participating schools and other organizations;
- contacting schools and other organizations and arranging a schedule for the workshops to take place;
- arranging and scheduling a training session for all volunteers;
- taking care of the evaluation process

All Local Coordinators from the same country will have a National Coordinator that will guide them and help them with their tasks throughout the whole mandate. If needed, they will also be able to contact the SII team.

The rough timeline includes:

- Stepping in contact with last year’s volunteers (with the help of NC and former LC) and starting to gather new volunteers – **beginning of October**
- Contacting institutions for potential workshops – **mid-October**
- Organising training for new volunteers – **November**
- Overseeing the workshops delivered – **until June**
- Filling out the evaluation form – **end of June**
