

General Prerequisites | Executive Board

This document outlines the general requirements for an individual to apply for a position within the European Federation of Psychology Students' Associations' Executive Board (EFPSA EB). In addition to the specific Role Description of the position you wish to apply for which you can find in the call on the website, we kindly ask you to read through these general prerequisites outlined in this document, which are intended to generate a clear idea of one's expectations.

Requirements

- A strong command of the English language
- Availability to work online
- Strong working ethic
- Honest and respectful attitude towards others
- Clear awareness of the responsibilities and requirements inherent to the position being applied for
- Willingness to learn about EFPSA's Corporate Visual Identity (CVI), EFPSA's Statutes and Internal Regulations together with the Mission, Vision and Values
- Nominated candidates are asked to sign a Code of Conduct, outlining one's ethical commitments towards EFPSA, after their nomination
- Providing a detailed knowledge transfer upon completion of the mandate
- Attendance at the Joint Executive Board and Member Representatives' Meeting in November 2020 (preferable)
- Being a psychology student or having graduated from a psychology course no longer than two academic years ago in a country that is a member of EFPSA
